

You can afford to pay cash

- Local shops (discounts may be available from some shops)

You cannot afford to pay cash but are likely to get credit

NB: Check the interest rate and total amount to be repaid, try and avoid Pay Day loans as they have high interest rates

Carpets can be one of your biggest expenses when moving home or when refurbishing your current home. Beware of some of the pay-weekly carpets that you find on the internet, some of them can be over-priced and poor quality, always do your research. Finance options available from Hoot Credit Union are a good choice. Bolton Nice can also provide carpets, sometimes new sometimes used, they will also fit them for you. Some carpet shops offer their own finance, shop around to get the best deal for you. Some local shops may offer a discount for Bolton at Home tenants.

You cannot afford to pay cash and are unlikely to get credit

If you are taking on a new tenancy

- 1. You could get a Furnished Tenancy? (This would need to be agreed with the new landlord before the tenancy starts and only social housing tenants can apply).
- 2. If you have been on benefits for 6 months or more, you MAY be able to get a Budgeting Loan or a Budgeting Advance from the Department of Work and Pensions DWP.

- 3. You MAY be eligible to apply for Local Welfare Provision (LWP). www.bolton.gov.uk/benefits/help-crisis-emergency
- 4. Does your new landlord have a hardship fund you could access?
- 5. Are there any other trust funds or grants you could be entitled to? (See links overleaf)
- 6. Can you get free preowned goods from anywhere? (see links overleaf)

If you are not taking on a new tenancy,

- you will not be able to change to a Furnished Tenancy
- you will not be eligible for LWP unless there has been a disaster
- 2. 4. 5. & 6. above could still be options.



<u>Trust Funds</u> – These may be available for customers to apply for grants for furniture, white goods etc however it is by no means exhaustive: -

Turn2us - a national charity that helps people in financial hardship gain access to welfare benefits, charitable grants and support services.

United Utilities Trust Fund – for United Utilities customers in financial hardship. Applications can be made online through the website http://www.uutf.org.uk or an application can be printed and submitted freepost.

British Gas Energy Trust_ - Applications can be made online at the website http://www.britishgasenergytrust.org.uk or an application form can be printed and submitted via post. Families and individuals in need, suffering or other distress fit the criteria and they can apply for;

Household items which includes gas/electric cooker; fridge-freezer, washing machine; tumble dryer; washer/dryer; gas fire; bed; carpets (up to a maximum of £500 including fitting costs); microwave and vacuum cleaner. (Limited to one household item per application)
